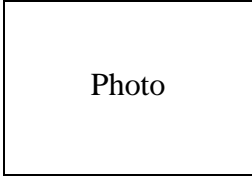

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSE

In case the Student does not have an English Language knowledge confirmation in the form of certificate on at least B2 level, gained within 1 year before application date, Student is required to take a free obligatory online exam determining her/his level of English within recruitment process. In that situation, the University of Białystok will provide a student with: a link, a login, and a password to take the exam on the Online Education Platform. If based on the exams results the student obtains:

- at least B2 level, the student may not attend the additional English language course,
- lower than B2 level, the Student is obliged to take the *60h Obligatory English language course* (duration – 1 semester, cost - approximately 255,00 EUR),
- lower than A2 level, the Student is obliged to take the *200h Obligatory English language course* (duration – 1 semester, cost – approximately 885,00 EUR),

The student is obligated to take the exam on the Online Education Platform until .../.../20..., otherwise he/she will be automatically assigned for 200h Obligatory English language course. English language courses are organized by the Centre for Foreign Language Teaching. Please note that the University of Białystok reserves the right to change the fees for the courses as a result of the change of the number of students in the groups and EUR currency exchange rate.

Information duty resulting from Art. 13 par. 1 and par. 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):

Art. 6 par. 1 item b of General Data Protection Regulation, i.e. - processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract;

Art. 6 par. 1 item c of General Data Protection Regulation, i.e. - processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject;

Art. 6 par. 1 item f of General Data Protection Regulation, i.e. - processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller.

5. Providing personal data as well as surplus data is voluntary but necessary to be hosted at University of Białystok.
6. Data may be disclosed to your home institution or other external entities such as: recruitment agencies, agencies intercessory in recruitment process, visa application agencies, embassies, consulate offices, police departments, border guard departments, students organizations, students associations, university and students research groups, dormitory administration, Centre for Foreign Language Teaching administration, School of Polish Language and Culture administration etc. and in cases envisaged by the provisions of law.
